### A message from Mrs Wilson

Dear parents and carers,

The Summer Term is always a very busy term with lots of exciting events planned. A summary of all of the activities and diary dates are included in the table overleaf. Diary dates for the infant school are in the left hand column (light grey shading) and diary for the junior school are in the right hand column. Some events are for both schools and are shaded in dark grey.

I am delighted to announce that we are in the final stages of having a brand new logo for the Lumley Primary Federation. All pupils across both schools produced a logo design. The infant school council and the junior class ambassdors reviewed all of the children's designs and selected their favourite ones. The shortlisted designs were then reviewed by members of the Lumley Primary Federation Governing Body and four designs were chosen. The winning designs will be announced in a special assembly and then shared on WEDUC along with the new logo. It is anticipated that the new uniform will be ready for purchase from June 2023.

### King Charles III Coronation Celebrations – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May

We will be celebrating King Charles III Coronation with a garden party on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May in the afternoon. This will a **non-uniform day**, where children can dress in **red, white and blue**. During foundation subject lessons, pupils will be learning about King Charles, the Monarchy and the Commonwealth.



Morning nursery children are invited to attend the afternoon session on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May from 11:30 till 3:00 and can pay for the Coronation lunch. Afternoon children are also invited to the lunch and to attend Nursery from 11:30am instead of 12:15pm. 30 hours children to attend as normal.

If parents of morning children do not want their child to attend the Coronation Party, they can be collected as normal at 11:30 am.

Teachers across the Federation are busy organising educational visits for this term for all year groups apart from Year 6. Information regarding the visits will be sent out shortly. Year 6 pupils have had several educational visits and a residential visit during this academic year. To celebrate the huge success of our children's primary education, Year 6 pupils will join their current teachers and past teachers for a fun stargazing evening full of outdoor adventures and a BBQ on the evening of Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July at 6pm.
