Dear parents and carers,

We have had a wonderful start to the new school year. A very warm welcome to our new children and families. I am delighted with how well all of the children have settled into their new classes across the Lumley Primary Federation. The children look so smart in the new federation uniform. Please remember, your children can continue to wear the infant or junior uniform until they have outgrown it. We have managed to secure some funding from the Area Action Partnership to support families with the cost of uniform. I am sorry that this funding was not available before the summer holiday. If you would like some financial support in buying school uniform, please contact the school offices. A huge thank you to Councillor Bell and Councillor Heavyside for supporting our bid.

The autumn term is always a very busy term. On the back of this newsletter you will find a calendar of all of the events taking place in both schools.

Curriculum information for parents was sent home last week as well as our homework policy (they can also be found on Weduc and the school website). I hope they provide you with useful information about what your child will be learning in each subject and how you can support with their learning at home.

Following a trial in Year Two and Year Three classes, we have introduced White Rose Maths homework books from Year One, and Language and Literacy homework books, once your child has finished their phonics programme. Please only complete that week's homework. This week will be Week 2 homework and this will be dated. I hope you find that they give you a better insight to the learning that has taken place in school and provides you with guidance on how you can support your child with their homework. Your child still has access to high quality online educational programmes to support their learning at home and school, for example Numbots, TT Rockstars, Doodle, Reading Buddies, to name just a few.

Notices:

<u>Winter bugs and illnesses:</u> We have lots of winter bugs in both schools. Please follow NHS guidance in "Is My Child Too III For School" (https://www.nhs.uk/live-well/is-my-child-too-ill-for-school/) as to whether pupils should attend school or not. Children can attend school with a minor cough, runny nose or sore throat. However, children should not be sent to school if they have a temperature of 38°C or above.

<u>Parking</u> The safety of our pupils and their families is vitally important. Please be careful when driving and parking near our schools - park away from the school entrances and walk the short distance to the gate. Let's keep our children safe.

<u>Play equipment at both schools</u> The play equipment (climbing frame, adventure trail, gym equipment etc.) must only be used by pupils when a member of school staff is available to supervise. Please do not let your children play on the equipment before and after school when staff aren't present.
